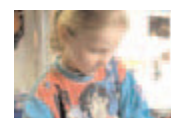
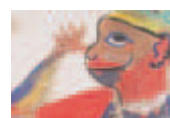
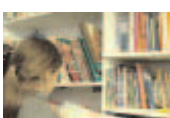


### Sponsored Events:
